- Prices & items listed are subject to change without notice
- Large loads **MUST** arrive 15 minutes prior to closing time. If needed, bring help to unload.
- Clear bags are **REQUIRED** for household garbage
- Clear bags are available for purchase at each collection site
- A Solid Waste & Recycling Permit **MUST be displayed** upon entering the collection site yard and are valid for **household trash only**
- Residents who do not display a current Colfax or Elk Mound Permit will be charged **\$3.00 per bag** for household trash. Permits can be obtained by contacting the Village of Colfax Clerk's Office 715-962-3311 during business hours Monday thru Friday 8am to 4pm
- Solid Waste Permits for Non-Participating Municipalities are \$200 per year
Permit costs are pro-rated after June 30th to \$100 for the remaining portion of the year.
- Replacement permits are available for a \$10 charge

HOUSEHOLD TRASH

***Normal household trash disposal is FREE with a current Colfax or Elk Mound Solid Waste Permit. Normal household trash is defined as standard items that are disposed of in an indoor, household trash receptacle on a regularly occurring basis. Typically, this refers to wastebaskets in the kitchen, bathroom and other household rooms. *This definition has been expanded to include a variety of additional common items that are typically generated as part of normal household upkeep such as:*

RECYCABLES NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS TIME

- *Plastic grain & seed sacks
 - *Styrofoam, packaging pieces, cups, take-out containers
 - *Table drinking glasses, candle glass, pyrex & glass cooking dishes
 - *#1 PETE (*hinged clear clamshell plastic containers for raspberries, blueberries, lettuce, donuts etc.:*)
 - * #4 LDPE film (*shopping, bread, dry cleaning & sandwich bags, shrink wrap, squeezable tubes for lotions etc.:*)
 - * #5 PP plastic containers (*yogurt, sour cream, cottage cheese, margarine, deli plastic containers, orange pill bottles, etc.:*)
 - * #5 PP plastic kitty litter buckets give to attendants for recycling yard use
- ***Just because a plastic type can be recycled doesn't mean plastic recycling companies want it, reason being, some plastic products are hard-to-process. Example, #4 LDPE, shopping bags and shrink wrap get tangled in the equipment

***Non-PCB ballasts - Non-PCB ballasts *must* have the statement "No PCB's" clearly marked on the label. If no label is present, a manufacturing stamp date of August, 1979 or later indicates that it does not contain PCB's.

***Ballasts w/PCB's - Ballasts with a manufacturing stamp date of July, 1979 or before shall be considered a PCB ballast. Ballasts manufactured after this date *must* have the statement "No PCB's" on the product label To be considered a Non-PCB ballast. All PCB ballasts must be stored in a 55-gallon steel drum with a lid.

COMPRESSED OR PRESSURIZED GAS CYLINDERS

The law requires any cylinder/container which was under pressure, to be cut in half for it to be legally permissible to go into a scrap metal collection program. Because of the danger involved with this process, the village must work with an outside vendor that will process these items properly, with that there is a cost associated. ***DO NOT PUT INTO LARGE METAL CONTAINER IN YARD

C & D Waste at Collection Sites : \$20.00 - \$40.00 per cubic yard, depending on weight

- A cubic yard is 3' long x 3' wide x 3' high

Heavy C & D Material - \$40.00 per cubic yard (some examples are as listed below)

- *Shingles
- *Lumber
- *Drywall
- *Large/heavy pieces of furniture (such as wooden bed frames, cabinets, book shelves, etc)
- *Cinder blocks or concrete

Lighter C & D Material - \$20.00 per cubic yard (some examples are as listed below)

- *Insulation/foam
- *Small quantities of plywood/cutoffs mixed with other items

- *Miscellaneous small household/non-recyclable plastic items
- *Small carpet or padding rolls

*Medications - The Colfax & Elk Mound Police Departments will collect unwanted medications year-round.

***SHARPS DISPOSAL** - Please check with local clinics, hospitals or vendors in which you receive your medical supplies.
