1. Call to order and meeting recording announcement
2. Roll call
3. Notice of publication: Posted on the town hall window and town website on May 11, 2026 and abbreviated notice published in the Dunn County Newspaper May 20, 2026.
4. Select chairperson for BOR
5. Select a Vice-Chairperson for BOR
6. Training requirement met: In 2026, at least one member of the BOR must attend a training session approved by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue before the 2026 BOR's first meeting. Jerry Mrdutt has met the training requirements for 2026.
7. Review the town has an ordinance for the confidentiality of income and expense information provided to the assessor.
8. Review of new laws.
9. Adoption of policy regarding the procedure for sworn telephone and sworn written testimony.
10. Adoption of policy regarding the procedure for waiver of BOR hearing requests.
11. Filing and summary of Annual Assessment Report by Assessor's Office.
12. Receipt of the assessment roll by Clerk from the Assessor.
13. Receive the Assessment Roll and sworn statements from the Clerk.

14. Review Assessment Roll and perform statutory duties:
 - a. Examine the roll
 - b. Correct description or calculation errors
 - c. Add omitted property
 - d. Eliminate double assessed property
15. Discussion/Action-Certify all corrections of error under State Law (Sec.70.43, WI Stats.)
16. Discussion/Action-Verify with the Assessor that open book changes are included in the assessment roll
17. Allow taxpayers to examine assessment data
18. During the first two hours, consideration of:
 - a. Waivers of the required 48-hour notice of intent to file an objection when there is good cause
 - b. Requests for waiver of the BOR hearing allowing the property owner an appeal directly to the circuit court
 - c. Requests to testify by telephone or submit sworn written statement
 - d. Subpoena requests
 - e. Act on any other legally allowed/required BOR matters
19. Review Notices of Intent to File Objection
20. Proceed to hear objections from land owners-taxpayers, if any and if proper notice/waivers given unless scheduled for another date.
21. Consider/act on scheduling additional BOR date
22. Adjournment
